

Resolution

- InfraRoom recommends that IFC alignment 1.0 will be accepted by SCE and approved as a bSI Final Standard
- InfraRoom accepts the initial scope of the 1.1 alignment project and asks InfraRoom Steering group to organize funding and stakeholders
- InfraRoom agrees with the presented approach on alignment deployment pilots and encourages its members to participate in setting up pilots

Resolution

- The Infraroom acknowledges the contribution of Paul Scarponcini on behalf of OGC in the ongoing activities of InfraRoom

Resolutions

- The InfraRoom acknowledges the work of the French Minnd project regarding IFC-bridge and expects to receive a project plan this april in order to move towards an International IFC Bridge project.
- The InfraRoom supports the call of the Minnd project to convene an IFC Bridge expert panel meeting in June 2015.
- The infraRoom observed a list of activities on the official buildingSMART website that do not reflect the current approved work of InfraRoom. InfraRoom requests the website be brought up to date.

Resolutions

- InfraRoom acknowledges the strong interest in the Asset Management working group. The InfraRoom supports the intent of the working group to develop a project plan for a requirement definition study.
- The InfraRoom supports the call by ExCom to create an organizational charter. Furthermore, the InfraRoom recognizes the urgency and sets out to present the charter at the next summit in Singapore in October 2015.

Resolutions

- InfraRoom acknowledges the progress made by OGC on the InfraGML standard and InfraRoom encourages its members to review the published model. Furthermore, the InfraRoom endorses the manner in which bSI and OGC have cooperated and recommends its continuation.
- InfraRoom recommends the renewal of the MOU between bSI and OGC to include the full scope of InfraRoom activities.

Resolution

- The InfraRoom endorses the bS MVD for LandXML 1.2 as bSI Recommended Technical Report (Recommended TR) and to circulate it to the Standards Committee for endorsement as bSI Final Technical Report (Final TR).

Resolution

- The InfraRoom supports the establishment of a working group to address the integration of spatial and built environment modelling and proposes to suspend the “*integrated built environment life cycle model working group*” while the new group refines its work plan.

- The Infrastructure Room approves the bSI IFC Roads initiative for further development and team formation.
- InfraRoom notes that Chapters and other stakeholders present in the IFC Roads working group meeting are committed to perform a review of the KICT IDM, data schema and documents and provide an assessment of their own exchange requirements compared to the KICT work, in the next 60 days. This assessment will include consideration of railroads.
- The InfraRoom supports the intention of the IFC Roads working group to draft an amended project proposal to take in account feedback received during the working group meeting. First draft will be distributed to the current working group participants in 14 days, and a teleconference will be scheduled in 30 days to discuss the amended proposal.

- The InfraRoom acknowledges the contribution from KICT in preparing and translating the documents that relate to their IFC Roads project and thanks them for sharing the documentation with InfraRoom.
